Guidelines, Eligibility, Rules

- Must be a full-time student.
- Complete all paper work
- Be able to pick up tickets from accounting office when application is completed.
- Be able to sell tickets and replenish supply of tickets from accounting office
- Must be less than 18 years of age.
- Must be an enrolled member of the Lummi Tribe or proof of direct relationship.
- Must have and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher.
- Must not have previously held the title of Sr. Miss Lummi Stommish Princess / Warrior.
- Must not be married.
- Must not have any children or become pregnant during the duration of the reign.
- Must have effective communication and interpersonal skills.
- Must have a working knowledge of Lummi traditions, history, culture, and customs.
- Must be willing to represent the Lummi Nation and its activities, particularly the Lummi Stommish Water Festival.
- Must be responsible for own traditional and contemporary attire.
- Must be responsible for her/his own transportation to functions throughout her/his reign.
- Must be willing and able to assist planning student activities when pertinent and collaborate with a diverse population for youth issues.

2011 Miss Lummi Stommish Competition Information

The selection of Miss Lummi Stommish & Junior Miss Lummi Stommish will be made on the basis of the categories listed below. Time limits will be strictly adhered to and loss of points will result for contestants who exceed the stated time limit.

Letter of Recommendation

The letter will be submitted with the application materials.

Letter must be written by a community member, tribal member, schoolteacher, or family friend, etc.

Essay

Essay will be submitted with the application materials. It may not be longer than two pages and must be formatted in Times New Roman, 12-point font, double-spaced, and 1-inch margins.

Personal Interview

The personal interview will be conducted with the judges and will last approximately 20 minutes. As a general guideline, please be available the day before the pageant Talent Showcase, during the afternoon.

The Talent Showcase

The following categories will take place during the pageant Talent Showcase and will be open to the public.

Traditional Talent

Contestants must wear tribal dress and perform a traditional talent of their choice. Contestants are not allowed to change their traditional talent after the application deadline.

Contemporary Talent

Contestants should wear appropriate attire for their selected contemporary talent. Contestants are not allowed to change their contemporary talent after the application deadline.

Impromptu Question

Contestants will be given one minute to address a question.

Raffle Ticket Sales

Contestants will receive 20 percent of their sales back on the Sunday following the pageant.

- Act with respectful and appropriate behavior when serving as Miss Lummi Stommish Princess / Warrior or 1st Attendant. Realize that I am serving as a role model for other Lummi youth.
- Not participate or be arrested in a criminal act (underage drinking, drive while intoxicated, using illegal drugs, theft, etc.). If I do so, I understand that my title as Miss Lummi Stommish Princess / Warrior will be forfeited and given to the 1st Attendant. If I receive the title of 1st Attendant and do not abide by this rule, I will be required to surrender my title.
- Return the crown of Miss Lummi Stommish Princess and/or replace the crown with another of the same or greater value upon completion of the reign.
- Relinquish the title, crown, sash, gifts, and scholarship (amount dependent upon whether a scholarship was received and length of time served) to the First Attendant if dismissed before end of reign.
- Understand that the sponsoring individual and/or organization are not to be held responsible for any accidents of any kind while I am performing the duties of Miss Lummi Stommish Princess / Warrior
